# FUNDRAISING

## Team Fundraising Ideas

Here are some fun ways you and your team can raise money for people in need of safe water.

### Car Wash

Wash your parents', teachers', or neighbors' cars in return for a \$5 donation.

### Yard Sale

Encourage your friends, family, and neighbors to have a major clear out of old toys and clothes for a garage/yard sale.

### Book Sale

Get your entire classroom/school to bring in used books, CDs, DVDs and host a community book sale.

### Turn the Tap

Put a collection box by each sink in your home, school, or place of worship, and ask that people donate 10 or 25 cents every time they turn the water tap/faucet.

### Water Assembly

Hold a water assembly, followed by a donation collection. Stand up and tell your school about Water 1st, the need for safe water, and your participation in the Carry 5 walk. Show the Water 1st film/DVD. Ask students, parents, teachers to donate.

### Lunch-time Collection

Put a couple of collection boxes in your school cafeteria so that students can donate their spare change from lunch.

### Drink Water Day

Give up all drinks apart from water for the day and donate \$1 that you would have spent on tea, coffee, or carbonated drinks. Ask your family and friends to join you.

### Greeting Cards

Make your own greeting cards and sell them to friends, family, neighbors.

### Bake Sale or Candy Sale

Sell baked goods, popcorn, candy, or popsicles at your school or place of worship.

### Soak the Teacher or Parent

Persuade your teacher, principal, or parent to take part and ask friends, students, (and teachers!) to pay to throw a wet sponge at them.

### Movie Night

Host a movie night at your school. Charge admission, and sell popcorn, baked goods, and beverages.
